

### Acquisition of Discovery Data positions ISS Market Intelligence as an international market leader in intermediary data

#### Transaction overview

#### **Purchase Price**

- Full acquisition (100%) of Discovery Data valued at ~€200 million
- Funded with DB1 cash on hand

#### **Financials**

- 2021E net revenue of ~€19 million growing 12% and ~43% EBITDA margin
- High recurring subscription data revenue (~94%) with more than 1,000 clients

#### Timing / Reporting

- Signed on 29 October 2021
- Expected to close at the end of Q4/2021
- Discovery Data will be part of "Non-ESG" in financial reporting

#### Company snapshot


- Founded in 2002, Discovery Data is the market leading supplier of mission critical financial intermediary data for the financial services industry, serving the sales, distribution and recruitment departments of asset managers, advisors and insurers
- Discovery Data gathers information through connections to more than 100 disparate structured and unstructured data sources that are constantly updated and cleansed using a proprietary automated matching and verification engine, supplemented by Discovery Data's analysts

#### Strategic rationale

- Immediately provides ISS with US market coverage, complementing similar international data sets within ISS Financial Clarity in UK and ISS Rainmaker in Australia and positioning ISS as the unprecedented go-to-provider
- Leveraging core ISS data capabilities while ISS BrightScope (US) and ISS Local Market Share (US) products are benefitting from linkage to US intermediary data and further strengthens asset managers and insurance relationships in (home) US market


## Strong organic and inorganic growth trajectory is expected to continue

#### Historic development



- 16 bolt-on M&A transactions since 2014 contributed to growth
- Aim was to further expand into ESG, data and analytics globally
- Largest transactions were the acquisitions of Strategic Insight (Mar 2019) and Discovery Data (closing expected in Q4/21)

#### Progress since consolidation



#### Outlook

- Guidance at the time of the announcement (Nov 2020):
  - >5% organic net revenue growth
  - ~35% adjusted EBITDA margin with further operating leverage
  - Additional €15 million EBITDA from revenue synergies by 2023
- Financial performance in 2021 so far significantly above initial expectations
- With strong organic growth prospects and bolt-on M&A double-digit net revenue growth targeted
