



GoGreen

Since May 2011, Deutsche Börse Group ships all letter mail and parcels at the location Frankfurt/Eschborn via the GoGreen initiative by Deutsche Post/DHL. At the location Luxembourg, all parcels have been shipped via this environmentally friendly and sustainable programme since the end of 2010. By using a CO₂ neutral mailing service, Deutsche Börse uses a “green” solution for sending letter mail and parcels. As part of the GoGreen offering, Deutsche Post measures the CO₂ emissions produced during transport and handling of shipments and balances them by providing corresponding financial support for climate protection projects. This enables us to offset the effects of shipping on the climate at a rate of 100 percent.

We aim to extend this approach to all other Group locations. In addition, we are continually trying to reduce the volume of our mailings, for example by sending invitations to events by e-mail or making our reports available online.
